4	<p>Insurance, original and copy</p> <p>1. Insurance coverage:</p> <p>1) The insurance policy should indicate clearly its validity for whole Schengen area. The insurance covering France only is not compliant.</p> <p>2) If the travel insurance policy doesn't indicate Schengen area and the zones covered by insurance are shown in the clauses, please also provide the photocopies of insurance clauses (English or French translation required, if the policy is in Chinese).</p> <p>2. Insurance period:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Short-stay Schengen Visa (less than 90 days): The insurance coverage should cover the first period of your stay in Schengen area. 	Y	Y

Please kindly note that the visa holders have the obligation to present such insurance on each of their trips.</p> <p>3. • Short-stay Visa for DROM/CTOM (less than 90 days): The insurance should cover the whole period of your stay in DROM/CTOM.</p> <p>3. Insured amount: The insurance must cover medical fees and repatriation costs up to 30.000 Euro (around 300.000 RMB), and the cost of out-patient and in-patient in your travel insurance must be up to 30.000 Euro.</p> <p>Purchase full insurance coverage for the Schengen area directly at the Visa Application Centre! 5	<p>Invitation letter (university, seminar, etc) original or copy</p> <p>On official company paper with stamp and signature, mentioning clearly: the full address and contacts of the company; the name and position of the countersigning officer; purpose + duration of the visit; detailed program; the person or the entity who will bear your travel and living cost; or copy of this original invitation letter.</p> <p>(For applications submitted at the Beijing consular area (Beijing/Xi'an/Jinan), translation in French or English is mandatory.)</p>	Y	Y
6	<p>Working certificate, original and translation</p> <p>Original letter issued by employing company, on official company paper with stamp, signature, date and clearly mentioning:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - current address, telephone and fax numbers of the company; - the name and position in the company of the countersigning officer; - the name of the applicant, position, salary and years of service; - the purpose of the visit; 	Y	



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - confirmation of position after the return; - the person or the entity who will bear your travel and living costs; - approval for leaves or absence. <p>Translation is mandatory, if the certificate is not written in English or French.</p>		
7	Proof of qualifications, original and photocopy	Y	Y
8	<p>Bank statement of the applicant covering the last three months (except credit card record or deposits account), original</p> <p>For minor or unemployed applicant, you can also provide the bank statement of your parents or spouse.</p>	Y	
9	<p>Hukou, copy</p> <p>Copies of the whole hukou (family booklet). Only required for Chinese citizen.</p>		Y
10	<p>Passport, original</p> <p>A full national private passport or official travel document. For more information on passport standard, please refer to FAQ section of our website.</p> <p>Before submitting your application, please check the following:</p> <p>1. Passport validity:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - your passport should be issued less than 10 years. - For a short-stay Schengen visa (less than 90 days): expiration date must be no earlier than 3 months after the date of your return from the Schengen Area. - For Renewal of a circulation visa: expiration date must be 15 months after the day of visa application. - For a regular long stay visa (more than 90 days): expiration date must be 15 months after the scheduled departure day from China. <p>2. Your passport should contain two blank visa pages.</p> <p>3. Make sure your passport has not been altered or damaged.</p> <p>If your passport is damaged or validity is not sufficient, you must renew or change your passport.</p>	Y	Y



	<p>4. Signature on the last page of non-bio passport is required.</p> <p>Passport, copy Copies of the first 5 pages of the passport containing information, and all the visa pages containing visas or stamps.</p>		
<p>2 additional mandatory documents for submission by a representative:</p> <p>If you have obtained a Schengen visa with VIS remark issued within the past 59 months, you may entrust a representative to submit your visa application at visa centre. For detailed requirements for exemption of biometric enrolment, please refer to FAQ section of our website.</p>			
11	<p>Letter of authorization for visa application/passport return, original</p> <p>Download</p> <p>Mandatory if you choose to submit your application by a representative. Please download the standard template from our website. Other format is not accepted.</p> <p>1. The signature on the letter of authorization must be identical as the signature on applicant’s passport and visa application form. The form has to be filled out completely. No alteration is accepted.</p> <p>2. The letter can’t be sharable and each applicant has to present one original letter.</p> <p>3. Minor applicant (under the age of 18 on submission day): This letter must be signed by one parent or a legal guardian. An adult is authorized to accompany the underage applicant for the submission and enrollment of biometric data (Parents’ ID photocopies should be joined with the authorization letter). Please DO NOT sign the name of underage applicant.</p> <p>Please note that:</p> <p>(1) The authorization letter must be signed by a legal guardian. The representative is not authorized to sign it.</p> <p>(2) Personal appearance is not required for children under 12 years old.</p> <p>If a parent submit the application for his/her minor child, the authorization is not required. In this case, he/she must provide clear family relation proofs.</p>	Y

13	Chinese residence permit, original and copy A foreign applicant must hold a residence permit with a period of validity of no less than 6 months or a permanent residence card. The residence permit shall be valid after the return of applicant to China. Holders of a single-entry or a multi-entries visa are not allowed to apply for any visa except for airport transit visa.	Y	Y
