#### LONG STAY - CHILD OF A SCIENTIFIC RESEARCHER

You are the child of a person who is undertaking scientific research in a laboratory in France and you wish **to accompany them** and stay more than 90 days. You must provide your birth certificate authenticated by the Chinese Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

	<p><b>One recent identity photo</b></p> <p>Size 3.5 cm x 4.5 cm, color photo with white background, taken within 6 months and from the front without any head-coverings. 	<p><b>Long stay visa application form</b></p> <p>To download the form, please visit Links and Downloads page.</p>	Y		
<b>Mandatory for foreigners</b>	<p><b>Chinese residence permit</b></p> <p>A foreign applicant must hold a residence permit with a period of validity of no less than 6 months or a permanent residence card. Holders of a single-entry or a multi-entries visa are not allowed to apply for any visa except for airport transit visa.</p>	Y	Y	
<b>For minors (&lt; 18 years old)</b>	<p><b>Notarial certificate of birth OR notarial certificate of family relationship between parents / legal guardian and the minor applicant. All these acts must be legalized by the Chinese Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Chinese Embassy or the Waiban, original containing translation in English or in French</b></p> <p>For foreigners: Notarial certificate of Medical Certificate of Birth, legalized by the Embassy/Consulate of your country in China, original containing translation</p> <p>Original and/or photocopy can be kept by the Consular Authority.</p>	Y	Y	



<p><b>For minors</b> <b>(&lt; 18 years old)</b></p>	<p><b>Notarial certificate of parental authority delegation certified by the Chinese Ministry Of Foreign Affairs or by the Chinese Embassy, original containing translation</b></p> <p>For foreigners: Certificate of parental authority delegation, original containing translation</p> <p>This document should contain the parents' signature and should define the person in charge for the underage in Schengen area. Mandatory if the child is traveling alone or with only one of the parents.</p> <p><b>This document is not mandatory if the child submit visa application at the same time with their parents' application.</b></p>	Y	Y	
<p><b>For adults</b> <b>(&gt; 18 years old)</b></p>	<p><b>Proof of financial dependence of the child</b></p> <p>If the child is an adult (more than 18 years old).</p>	Y		
	<p><b>Inviter's resident card</b></p>		Y	
	<p><b>Convention d'accueil</b></p> <p>This document must be signed and stamped by inviting organization indicating the purpose and duration of stay in France.</p>		Y	
	<p><b>Passport</b></p> <p>A full national private passport or official travel document valid for at least more than 3 months beyond the validity of the requested visa, with two blank visa pages with the mention "visa" to affix the visa sticker. Should be issued less than 10 years ago. For more information about "Passport Validity" please visit FAQ page.</p> <p>Copies of the first 5 pages of the passport containing information, and all pages that contain visas or stamps.</p>	Y	Y	
	<p><b>Previous passports</b></p> <p>If you are in possession of one or more previous passports, it is mandatory to provide them.</p> <p>Copies of the first 5 pages of every previous passport, and all the pages that contain visas or stamps.</p>	Y	Y	
<p><b>2 additional mandatory documents for submission by a representative:</b></p> <p>For the following main visa categories:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• long-stay visa application (above 90 days)</li> </ul>

Applicants of 12 years old or above on the day of submitting visa application must go through the biometric data capture step for each new application, even if they have already submitted their fingerprints for a previous visa application. For more information, please visit FAQ page.

	<p><b>Letter of authorization for visa application/passport return</b></p> <p>Mandatory if you choose to submit your application by a representative.  <a href="#">Download.</a></p> <p><b>Requirements:</b></p> <p><b>1. The signature on the letter of authorization needs to be the same as the one in the applicant’s passport and Visa application form. The form has to be filled out completely. No correction is allowed on the form.</b></p> <p><b>2. The letter can’t be shared and each applicant has to present the original.</b></p> <p><b>3. Minor applicant under the age of 18: The letter of authorization must be signed by one parent or a legal guardian: An adult is authorized to accompany the underage applicant for the submission and enrollment of biometric data (Parents’ ID photocopies should be joined with the authorization letter) Please DO NOT sign the name of the underage applicant.</b></p> <p><b>Please note that:</b></p> <p><b>(1) The authorization letter must be signed by a legal guardian. The representative is not authorized to sign it.</b></p> <p><b>(2) Personal appearance is not required for children under 12 years old.</b></p> <p>The age on the date of application submission is taken as reference to determine if an applicant is a minor or not.</p> <p>The authorization is not required, if parents submit the application for their minor-aged children. However, they should provide evidence proving the family relation (such as hukou etc.).</p>	Y
