Mandatory for foreigners	<p>Chinese residence permit</p> <p>A foreign applicant must hold a residence permit with a period of validity of no less than 6 months or a permanent residence card. Holders of a single-entry or a multi-entries visa are not allowed to apply for any visa except for airport transit visa.</p>	Y	Y

	<p>Notarial translation (in French or English) of the birth certificate or the family relationship, certificate certified by the Chinese Ministry Of Foreign Affairs and by the French Consular authority</p> <p>For foreigners: Notarial translation (in French or English) of the birth certificate or the family relationship certificate certified by the Embassy/Consulate of your country in China and by the French Consular authority</p> <p>Original and/or photocopy can be kept by the Consular authority.</p>	Y	Y	
<p>For minors (<18 years old)</p>	<p>Notarial certificate (in French or English) of parent authorizing the child to live permanently in France with the parent who will settle in France certified by the Chinese Ministry Of Foreign Affairs and by the French Consular authority</p> <p>For foreigners: Notarial certificate of parental authority delegation certified by the Embassy/Consulate of your country in China, original containing translation</p> <p>Original and/or photocopy can be kept by the Consular authority.</p> <p>Not mandatory if both of the parents are asking for family accompaniment.</p>	Y		
	<p>Applicant's parent's (who lives in France) passport</p>		Y	
<p>For minors, if the parents are divorced</p>	<p>Notarial translation (French or English) of the divorce statement mentioning the custody of the child certified by the Chinese Ministry Of Foreign Affairs and by the French Consular authority</p> <p>For foreigners: Notarial translation (French or English) of the divorce statement mentioning the custody of the child certified by the Embassy/Consulate of your country in China or by the French Consular authority</p>		Y	
	<p>Passport</p> <p>A full national private passport or official travel document valid for at least more than 3 months beyond the validity of the requested visa, with two blank visa pages with the mention "visa" to affix the visa sticker. Should be issued less than 10 years ago. For more information about Passport Validity please check FAQ page.</p>	Y	Y

<p>2 additional mandatory documents for submission by a representative:</p> <p>For the following main visa categories:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • long-stay visa application (above 90 days) • visiting the DROM-CTOM <p>Applicants of 12 years old or above on the day of submitting visa application must go through the biometric data capture step for each new application, even if they have already submitted their fingerprints for a previous visa application. For more information, please visit FAQ page.</p>				
	<p>Letter of authorization for visa application/passport return</p> <p>Mandatory if you choose to submit your application by a representative. Download.</p> <p>Requirements:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The signature on the letter of authorization needs to be the same as the one in the applicant’s passport and Visa application form. The form has to be filled out completely. No correction is allowed on the form. 2. The letter can’t be shared and each applicant has to present the original. 3. Minor applicant under the age of 18: The letter of authorization must be signed by one parent or a legal guardian: An adult is authorized to accompany the underage applicant for the submission and enrollment of biometric data (Parents’ ID photocopies should be joined with the authorization letter) Please DO NOT sign the name of the underage applicant. <p>Please note that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) The authorization letter must be signed by a legal guardian. The representative is not authorized to sign it. (2) Personal appearance is not required for children under 12 years old. The age on the date of application submission is taken as reference to determine if an applicant is a minor or not. <p>The authorization is not required, if parents submit the application for their minor-aged children. However, they should provide evidence proving the family relation (such as hukou etc.).</p>		Y
