Mandatory for foreigners	<p>Chinese residence permit</p> <p>A foreign applicant must hold a residence permit with a period of validity of no less than 6 months or a permanent residence card. Holders of a single-entry or a multi-entries visa are not allowed to apply for any visa except for airport transit visa.</p>	Y	Y	
For minors (< 18 years old)	<p>Original notarial translation (in French or English) of the birth certificate or the family relationship certificate certified by the Chinese Ministry Of Foreign Affairs or by the Chinese consular authority at abroad.</p> <p>For foreigners: Notarial translation (in French or English) of the birth certificate or the family relationship certificate certified by the Embassy/Consulate of your country in China.</p>	Y	Y	



	<p>For individual applications submitted in Shanghai, Hangzhou and Nanjing centers (non ADS group applicants): All the notarial certificates legalized by Waiban of Shanghai, Jiangsu, Zhejiang and Anhui will be delivered directly to the Consulate General of France in Shanghai by Waiban. Only the original receipt from Waiban will be accepted by Visa center. <p>For minors (< 18 years old), and if minor travel alone, or travel with only one of parents, or travel with third part.</p>	<p>Notarial certificate of authorization to travel granted by both parents or legal guardians, legalized by the Chinese Ministry Of Foreign Affairs, and if the certificate is issued outside of China, attested by the competent authorities of the country of residence of child’s parents or legal guardians, original containing translation</p> <p>For foreigners: Notarial certificate (in French or English) of travel authorization granted by both parents or legal guardians, legalized by the Embassy/Consulates of your country in China. Original and/or photocopy can be kept by the Consular authority.</p> <p>Not mandatory if both of the parents are asking for family accompaniment.</p> <p>This document is not mandatory if the child submit visa application at the same time with their parents’ application.</p> <p>For individual applications submitted in Shanghai, Hangzhou and Nanjing centers (non ADS group applicants): All the notarial certificates legalized by Waiban of Shanghai, Jiangsu, Zhejiang and Anhui will be delivered directly to the Consulate General of France in Shanghai by Waiban. Only the original receipt from Waiban will be accepted by Visa center. 	<p>Passport</p> <p>A full national private passport or official travel document valid for at least more than 3 months beyond the validity of the requested visa, with two blank visa pages with the mention “visa” to affix the visa sticker. Should be issued less than 10 years ago. For more information about “Passport Validity” please visit FAQ page.</p> <p>Copies of the first 5 pages of the passport containing information, and all pages that contain visas or stamps.</p>	Y	Y	
<p>2 additional mandatory documents for submission by a representative:</p> <p>For the following main visa categories:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • long-stay visa application (above 90 days) • visiting the DROM-CTOM <p>Applicants of 12 years old or above on the day of submitting visa application must go through the biometric data capture step for each new application, even if they have already submitted their fingerprints for a previous visa application. 	<p>Letter of authorization for visa application/passport return</p> <p>Mandatory if you choose to submit your application by a representative.</p> <p>Download.</p> <p>Requirements:</p> <p>1. The signature on the letter of authorization needs to be the same</p>	Y		



	<p>as the one in the applicant’s passport and Visa application form. The form has to be filled out completely. No correction is allowed on the form.</p> <p>2. The letter can’t be shared and each applicant has to present the original.</p> <p>3. Minor applicant under the age of 18: The letter of authorization must be signed by one parent or a legal guardian: An adult is authorized to accompany the underage applicant for the submission and enrollment of biometric data (Parents’ ID photocopies should be joined with the authorization letter) Please DO NOT sign the name of the underage applicant.</p> <p>Please note that:</p> <p>(1) The authorization letter must be signed by a legal guardian. The representative is not authorized to sign it.</p> <p>(2) Personal appearance is not required for children under 12 years old.</p> <p>The age on the date of application submission is taken as reference to determine if an applicant is a minor or not.</p> <p>The authorization is not required, if parents submit the application for their minor-aged children. However, they should provide evidence proving the family relation (such as hukou etc.).</p>			
	<p>Representative’s ID Card or passport</p> <p>Mandatory if you choose to submit your application by a representative.</p>	Y	Y
