SHORT STAY - TOURIST VISIT

You wish to go to France for a tourist visit. Please make sure that France is your main destination country and you will stay no longer than 90 days.

- If you intend to visit only one Schengen country (check more info in FAQ page), you must apply at the Embassy or Consulate of this country.
- If you intend to visit several Schengen countries, you must apply for a visa at the Embassy or Consulate of the country of your longest stay.
- If you intend to visit several Schengen countries but do not have a main destination (i.e. the duration of your stay is the same in different countries), you should apply for a visa at the Embassy or Consulate of the country that is your first point of entry.

If your travel purpose combines family/ friend/private visits and tourism, please choose the visa category “**Family, friend or private (less than 90 days)**”. Please note that wrong visa type may increase the risk of refusal. If you insist on applying for tourism visa, please submit an explanation letter in English or in French.

For minors (< 18 years old)	<p>Documents that need to be provided if the accompanying person travels together with the minor:</p> <p>If the accompanying person does not submit the application at the same time with the minor applicant (under 18 years old on the day of submission of the visa application); if the accompanying person's visa application is at the Embassy or Consulate; or if the accompanying person already has a valid visa for the country of destination, the following documents are required:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Photocopy of the passport of the appointed person responsible for the minor applicant during the travel period in the Schengen area. 2. Photocopy of a proof that the accompanying person can stay in the Schengen area during the travel period (e.g. copy of a valid visa page, a copy of a valid residence permit issued by the relevant local authorities, etc.) 3. 	Insurance 1. The travel insurance should be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Valid for Schengen area if you apply for short stay visa • Valid for France if it's required in the document list and you apply for long stay visa • Valid for DROM/CTOM according to your itinerary 2. The insurance must cover medical fees and repatriation costs up to 30.000 Euro (around 300.000 RMB), and the cost of out-patient and in-patient in your travel insurance must be up to 30.000 Euro. 3. The insurance coverage should cover the first period of your stay in Schengen area. (This point does not remove the requirement of the obligation of presenting an insurance for subsequent trips, as the periods indicated on application form). 	Previous passports If you are in possession of one or more previous passports, it is mandatory to provide them. Copies of the first 5 pages of every previous passport, and all the pages that contain visas or stamps.	Y	Y	



	<p>Letter of authorization for visa application/passport return</p> <p>Mandatory if you choose to submit your application by a representative. Download.</p> <p>Requirements:</p> <p>1. The signature on the letter of authorization needs to be the same as the one in the applicant’s passport and Visa application form. The form has to be filled out completely. No correction is allowed on the form.</p> <p>2. The letter can’t be shared and each applicant has to present the original.</p> <p>3. Minor applicant under the age of 18: The letter of authorization must be signed by one parent or a legal guardian: An adult is authorized to accompany the underage applicant for the submission and enrollment of biometric data (Parents’ ID photocopies should be joined with the authorization letter) Please DO NOT sign the name of the underage applicant.</p> <p>Please note that:</p> <p>(1) The authorization letter must be signed by a legal guardian. The representative is not authorized to sign it.</p> <p>(2) Personal appearance is not required for children under 12 years old.</p> <p>The age on the date of application submission is taken as reference to determine if an applicant is a minor or not.</p> <p>The authorization is not required, if parents submit the application for their minor-aged children. However, they should provide evidence proving the family relation (such as hukou etc.).</p>	Y
