FAMILY OF AN EU CITIZEN (LESS THAN 90 DAYS)

You are a member of the family of an EU citizen resident in Portugal, and you wish to visit them, for a stay of less than 90 days, without the intention of settling there

GENERAL DOCUMENTS FOR ALL APPLICANTS

[Schengen visa application form](#)

- *Duly completed and signed by the applicant.*

An identity photo

- *A standard identity photo;*
- *Size 3.5 cm x 4.5 cm, on a white background, less than 3 months old.*

Passport

- Passport, original
An ordinary passport or a recognized travel document with a validity of at least 3 months after the planned stay. The passport or travel document must contain at least two blank pages marked "visa" in order to affix a Visa. Must have been issued within the past 10 years. The photo used on the passport must resemble its holder at the time of filing.
- Passport, copy
*Photocopy of the pages of the passport containing personal identity data including a photocopy of the pages containing the extensions of validity, any remarks and **all pages containing the Schengen visas obtained**. Issued in the last 10 years, as well as entry and exit stamps.*

A copy of the round trip reservation and the detailed itinerary

- *Including dates and flight numbers, specifying the dates of entry and exit from this territory of the Member State.*



Evidence of family ties is linked to definition of family members

- *The persons designated as members of the nuclear family are described in the second paragraph of Article 2 of the directive. ⁽¹⁾*

Who needs this type of visa?

- *Members of the nuclear family automatically have the right to enter and reside in the country, regardless of their nationality.*
- *Third country nationals who are family members of European Union citizens must only hold an entry visa, in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 539/2001.*

⁽¹⁾ *The spouse;*

The partner with whom the citizen of the union has entered into a registered partnership, on the basis of the legislation of a Member State, if the legislation of the host Member State treats registered partnerships as equivalent to marriage and according to the conditions of the relevant legislation of the host Member State;

Direct descendants under the age of 21 or dependent and those of the spouse or partner as defined above;

The dependent direct parents in the ascending line and those of the spouse or partner as defined above.
