The letter must have an original signature (the name and position of the countersigning officer) and a stamp
- Personal (on the guarantor's name) bank statements from the last 6 months showing regular income (salaries, pension etc.)

If the guarantor is an owner of a company or a partner:

- Copy of the commercial register (Arabic + compulsory translation)
- Personal (on the guarantor's name) bank statements from the last 6 months showing regular income
- s/he can submit the bank statements of the company of the last 6 months with a letter from the bank proving s/he's a signatory on this bank account

Information: Bank statements should not be "credit card statements" but bank statements of a current account where we can see regular incomes (salary, pension, etc...)

Please highlight your regular income (salary, pension, etc...) on the bank statement

All bank statements must be in English (or translated by a sworn translator) and must show the guarantor's name, and be stamped and signed.
