



## Do I require a visa for Switzerland?

**Travellers wishing to enter Switzerland for the purpose of tourism, business trips and visits for a maximum stay of 90 days do NOT require a Schengen visa for Switzerland if they hold one of the following passports:**

### 1) BRITISH PASSPORT must contain one of the following remarks:

- “British Citizen” (B.C)
- “British National” (Overseas)”
- “British Overseas Territory Citizen”
- ”British Subject”
- “British Protected Persons”

### 2) TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

- UK travel document, issued to refugees by the Home Office, with blue cover, two black stripes (gold stripes since 16.08.96) in the top left hand corner and mentioning the UN Convention 28 July 1951
- UK travel document, issued to stateless people by the Home Office, with red cover and mentioning the UN Convention 28 September 1954
- LATVIA Alien’s Passport

### 3) NATIONAL, OFFICIAL or DIPLOMATIC PASSPORT, IDENTITY CARD

- of all EU countries and EEA

### 4) NATIONAL, OFFICIAL or DIPLOMATIC PASSPORT of any of the following countries:

#### 9) SCHOOL TRIPS EXEMPTION

Pupils of UK schools who would normally require a visa to enter Switzerland are exempt from

the visa requirements if they are listed on a “List of Travellers” form which must be shown to immigration officials. They must also:

- be travelling on a school trip
- be accompanied by a teacher from the school
- have their own valid travel document
- have a valid UK residence permit or visa
