### LIST OF DOCUMENTS

#### AIRPORT TRANSIT TYPE A

*Airport transit, type A*

All documents submitted must be in English, French, Dutch or German. The foreign official documents must be legalised or carry an apostil, unless an exemption is provided in a treaty.

**Please note** that you will need to separate 2 identical sets of documents (if documents are double sided, make sure you provide the photocopy of both sides).

### MANDATORY DOCUMENTS

**A duly completed and both signed VisaOnWeb application form (Signed copy)**

- The VisaOnWeb form with the bar code is available once the registration via [VisaOnWeb](#) is completed. Please note that will be the only application form accepted

**Use of language (Original)**

**Passport (Copy)**

- Valid for 3 month after the intended departure date from the Schengen-Zone;
- Which has been issued in the previous 10 years;
- Which contains 2 blank pages side by side.

**Two ID photos meeting the ICAO standards**

- Attached with a paper clip;
- In color;
- Size 3.5cm X 4.5cm;
- White plain background;
- Less than 3 months old.

**Copy of your UK residence permit**

- Which should be valid for 3 months after the intended departure date from the Schengen-zone.

**Copy of the passport bio-page**

- Page with photo;



- **UK visa page.**

**For EU family members (Original/Copy)**

- *proof of the relationship (marriage or birth certificate both the original and a copy, the original will need to be seen at the time of interview, but will be returned to you;*
- *Original and a copy of the passport or national ID card of the EU national.*

**Your flight tickets (Original/Copy)**

- *showing the transit via a Belgian airport;*
- *If you are returning with Belgium, please provide the tickets for both ways.*

***Additional documents, even if not featured in the list above, may be required by the Embassy. The applicant is hereby informed that submitting the above-mentioned documents does not guarantee automatic issuance of a visa.***

***IMPORTANT REMARK: Guarantees for return (assessment of migration risk): the applicant is requested to provide as much information as possible to document his/her family background, professional and socio-economic status, ownership of land or real estate (for instance: proof of family bonds with his/her country of origin, proof of regular income and stable source of revenues from the applicant and/or his/her partner, proof of property, etc.).***

*This information is essential to correctly judge the intention of the applicant to leave the Schengen area before the expiry of his/her visa.*
