## LIST OF DOCUMENTS

## MARRIAGE WITH A BELGIAN CITIZEN OR A FOREIGNER

Marriage with a Belgian citizen or a foreigner (holder of a card A or H or B, C, d, F or F+) (more than 90 days)

All documents submitted must be in English, French, Dutch or German.

**UK visa** page (equivalent of UK residence permit).

The foreign official documents must be legalized or carry an apostil, unless an exemption is provided in a treaty.

All the relevant information on this formality is available on the website of the SPF Foreign Affairs.

**Please note** that you will need to separate 2 identical sets of documents (if documents are double sided, make sure you provide the photocopy of both sides).

The decision will be taken by the Immigration Office in Belgium, which can take time. Please refer to the processing time page on our Website to find all the information.

## **MANDATORY DOCUMENTS**

$\square$ Two duly completed and both signed VisaOnWeb application forms (2 signed copies)
The VisaOnWeb form with the bar code is available once the registration via <u>VisaOnWeb</u> is completed.
Please note that will be the only application form accepted.
☐ Four (4) ID photos meeting the ICAO standards
Attached with a paper clip; In color;
• Size 3.5cm X 4.5cm;  White plain background;  Less than 3 months old.
☐ Passport (Original and 2 copies)
• A travel document where a visa can be issued with a minimum validity of 12 months (e.g.: a passport);
With at least 2 blank pages (side by side);
Not older than 10 years old from the first issue date.
☐ Passport bio-page (Original, Copy)
Original and Copy of the <b>Passport bio-page</b> ;





☐ Proof of the marriage declaration (Original, Copy)
Issued by registrar not more than 6 months prior to the visa application.
☐ Original and Recent Certificate of good conduct (Original and Copy)
If you are 18 years old and over, your original certificate of good conduct covering at least the last year. It must also
be <u>legalized</u> . Please note that one can't submit an DBS certificate in lieu of an ACRO/Police Certificate.
☐ A history of the relationship (Original, Copy)
☐ Travel insurance (Original, Copy)
☐ Proof of sufficient personal funds (Copy 2)
To cover the cost of the trip or a sponsorship form legalised (Annexe 3Bis).
☐ Literal copy of your birth certificate (Original, Copy)
☐ Original medical certificate (Original, Copy)
<ul> <li>By a medical practitioner approved by the Belgian Embassy, London;</li> <li>For the list of medical practitioners approved by the Embassy of Belgium in London please click <u>here</u>.</li> </ul>
$\square$ Copy of the identity card for the Belgian or a copy of the residence card for the foreigner (Copy 2)
$\square$ For the Belgian or Foreigner to be joined (Copy 2)
Copy of the birth certificate;
<ul> <li>Proof of sufficient accommodation;</li> <li>Proof of stable, regular and sufficient funds to support the family; □ Proof of Belgian medical insurance</li> </ul>
and social security;

Additional documents, even if not featured in the list above, may be required by the Embassy. The applicant is hereby informed that submitting the above-mentioned documents does not guarantee automatic issuance of a visa.





**IMPORTANT REMARK**: Guarantees for return (assessment of migration risk): the applicant is requested to provide as much information as possible to document his/her family background, professional and socio-economic status, ownership of land or real estate (for instance: proof of family bonds with his/her country of origin, proof of regular income and stable source of revenues from the applicant and/or his/her partner, proof of property, etc.).

This information is essential to correctly judge the intention of the applicant to leave the Schengen area before the expiry of his/her visa.
