HUMANITARIAN VISA

Humanitarian visa

- Official documents issued in Russia or in Belarus, Armenia, Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan and Kyrgyzstan must be apostilled/legalized and accompanied with a translation that must be apostilled/legalized.

Please provide 3 files (original + 2 sets of copies) following the order of above mentioned documents:

MANDATORY DOCUMENTS

☐ Original of passport

- Should be signed by the applicant;
- Should be valid for one year after the visa issuance date;
- Should contain at least one double blank page reserved for visas (blank front and back) for each applicant
 (if a child travels with parent in the parent's passport, there should be 2 blank pages (blank front and back),
 i.e. 4 blank pages);
- Without any damages.

☐ Two Long stay visa application forms

- Duly completed on Visa-On-Web in German, Dutch, French or English;
- Printed form with a bar code;
- Dated and signed by the applicant in person;
- In case of minors (below the age of 18), the application form needs to be signed **by parents or person exercising legal guardianship.**

For family members or groups application form must be filled in for each individual.

☐ Confirmation of administrative fees payment (original document + 2 copies)

• A contribution for administrative cost must be paid directly to the Ministry of Interior prior to submitting an application, please click here to find all the information on the cost, how to proceed and the exemptions.

☐ Two identity photos

• 2 identical, recent passport photographs, meeting Schengen photo requirements (two glued on each of application form).





PROOF OF TRIP PURPOSE

☐ Identific	ration document of inviter (2 copies)
• All	documents that can support the visa application for humanitarian reason.
☐ Solvenc	y proof of family member (original document + 2 copies)
-	family members in Belgium must show that they have regular and sufficient income and that they can ort the family without help from public funds.
☐ Proof of	accommodation (2 copies)
• Evid	dence of adequate housing in Belgium (property act, registered lease).
\square Proof of	relationship (if relevant)
• Orig	ginal document with Apostile and translation with Apostile + 2 copies
☐ Applicar	nt's birth certificate
• Orig	ginal document with Apostile and translation with Apostile + 2 copies
☐ Police C	earance (original document with Apostile and translation with Apostile + 2 copies)
	extract from your criminal record (Police clearance), not more than six months prior to the date of elication.
	nors (under 18 years old) are exempted from this requirement.
	OTHER DOCUMENTS
☐ Copy of	document proving legal residence in Russia/Jurisdiction (original document + 2 copies)
	Russian citizens living in Russia have to be legal residents of the Russian Federation and need to present vant documents (copy of residence permit, long-term visa or FMS registration).
	nts residing in Kazakhstan, Belarus, Armenia, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan and Kyrgyzstan aren't required to proof of legal residence in Russia.
\square Copy of	internal passport (2 copies)
 Cop 	ies of all pages with any stamps in it (the applicant's bio data, issued international passports, marital

status and registration in Russia etc.).
