Work visa issuance in the base of work permit (type B) or professional card.

If you don't receive professional card, please contact the Visa section of the Embassy by sending an email to <u>moscow.visa@diplobel.fed.be</u> to receive appropriate instructions.

- Official documents issued in Russia or in Belarus, Armenia, Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan and Kyrgyzstan must be apostilled/legalized and accompanied with a translation that must be apostilled/legalized.

Please provide 3 files (original + 2 sets of copies) following the order of above mentioned documents:

MANDATORY DOCUMENTS

□ Original of passport

- Should be signed by the applicant;
- Should be valid for one year after the visa issuance date;
- Should contain at least one double blank page reserved for visas (blank front and back) for each applicant (if a child travels with parent in the parent's passport, there should be 2 blank pages (blank front and back), i.e. 4 blank pages);
- Without any damages.

□ Two Long stay visa application forms

- Duly completed on <u>Visa-On-Web</u> in German, Dutch, French or English;
- Printed form with a bar code;
- Dated and signed by the applicant in person;
- In case of minors (below the age of 18), the application form needs to be signed **by parents or person** *exercising legal guardianship.*

For family members or groups application form must be filled in for each individual.

\Box Two identity photos

• 2 identical, recent passport photographs, meeting Schengen photo requirements (two glued on each of application form).





PROOF OF TRIP PURPOSE

□ Authorization from ODE/DVZ (original document + 2 copies)

- Authorization from ODE/DVZ annex 46 or 67 Authorization of issuance of D visa 'unique work permit' issued by Ministry of Interior;
- Work authorization issued by the competent region (Flanders, Wallonia or Brussels).

OTHER DOCUMENTS

□ Copy of document proving legal residence in Russia/Jurisdiction (original document + 2 copies)

All non-Russian citizens living in Russia have to be legal residents of the Russian Federation and need to present the relevant documents (copy of residence permit, long-term visa or FMS registration).

Applicants residing in Kazakhstan, Belarus, Armenia, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan and Kyrgyzstan **aren't required** to provide proof of legal residence in Russia.

□ Copy of internal passport (2 copies)

• Copies of all pages with any stamps in it (the applicant's bio data, issued international passports, marital status and registration in Russia etc.).

□ Consent for processing of personal data

□ Declaration of preferable language

• Please download the form Declaration of preferable language that can be found at section Links and Downloads page on our website, complete it, sign and attach with all your documents.
