LIST OF DOCUMENTS

FAMILY OF AN EU CITIZEN (LESS THAN 90 DAYS)

You are a member of the family of an EU citizen resident in Portugal, and you wish to visit them, for a stay of less than 90 days, without the intention of settling there

GENERAL DOCUMENTS FOR ALL APPLICANTS

Short stay visa application form

- *Original;*
- *Duly completed and signed by the applicant (Case 36 and 37 and the last two cases at the end of the Visa application form);*
- *Must be signed by both parents in case of the minor child;*
- *It is mandatory that the mentioned data information on the Schengen visa application form such as addresses, phone numbers etc. has to be identical with the personal data of the applicant.*

Passport

- *Original;*
- *With a validity of at least 3 months after the intended stay;*
- *Issued within the previous 10 years;*
- *With 2 blank pages;*
- *Copy.*

One recent passport size colour photo

- *Format 3.5 cm x 4.5 cm;*
- *Taken from the front, without obstruction;*
- *Recent (less than 6 months old);*
- *Ears and eyebrows must appear on the picture;*
- *The photo must be a close-up of your head and the top of your shoulders so that your face takes up 70-80% of the photograph.*

Copy of the round trip reservation and detailed itinerary

- *Including dates and flight numbers specifying the dates of entry and exit from the territory of the*



Member State (including itinerary to additional Schengen States).

Proof of family ties is linked to the Definition of family members

- *People referred to as members of the nuclear family are described in the second paragraph of Article 2 of the directive. ⁽¹⁾*

Who needs this type of visa?

- *Nuclear family members are automatically entitled to enter and reside in the country, regardless of their nationality.*
- *Nationals of third countries who are family members of EU citizens are only required to hold an entry visa, in compliance with Regulation (CE) n. ° 539/2001.*

⁽¹⁾ *The spouse;*

The partner with whom the citizen of the union has entered into a registered partnership, on the basis of the legislation of a Member State, if the legislation of the host Member State treats registered partnerships as equivalent to marriage and according to the conditions of the relevant legislation of the host Member State;

Direct descendants under the age of 21 or dependent and those of the spouse or partner as defined above;

The dependent direct parents in the ascending line and those of the spouse or partner as defined above.
