



MEDICAL TREATMENT

Information sheet for people who travel to Switzerland for medical treatment.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS AND GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- One (1) application form duly completed: in German, French, Italian, Spanish or English; online, by typewriter or in block letters with a blue or black pen; and personally signed by the applicant
- Signed passport, issued within ten (10) preceding years, valid at least three (3) months beyond the planned stay in the Schengen states and containing at least two (2) empty pages
- One (1) copy of the applicant's passport: pages 1–4; last page; all pages showing extension of validity; all pages with previously obtained visas
- Two (2) recent and identical, biometric passport-size pictures
- Visa application fee: EUR 80.-, children age 6 to 12: EUR 40.- (**TRY equivalence**)
- Original and one copy of a travel / health insurance; **minimum coverage EUR 30'000.- valid for all Schengen states** for the whole period of the intended stay. The insurance policy must cover the costs for repatriation in case of disease, urgent medical expenses and/or hospitalization.
- Minors** travelling without their legal representative(s) must bring an authorization of their legal representative(s) legalized by a notary (original and copy)
- Flight reservation (roundtrip)
- Letter of the hospital or medical institution confirming the patient's appointment for the medical treatment signed by the physician
- Physician's report
- Documents showing that the costs for the medical treatment (physician, hospital) and hotel are covered by the applicant (working documents, income statements, recent bank statements)

The Consulate General of Switzerland reserves the right to request additional documents and/or to summon the applicant for an interview.
