The application for study purposes is sent to the responsible migration authority in Switzerland, which is responsible for approving the application. The Consulate General of Switzerland can only issue the Visa D after receiving the authorization of the migration authorities.			
A waitir	ng period of at least 8-10 weeks must be expected (even longer, depending on the situation and the authorities).

0	A declaration of commitment (Verpflichtungserklärung) and proof of income or assets of a solvent person resident in Switzerland (if the latter is of foreign origin, he must also have a residence permit)		
0	Confirmation from a bank licensed in Switzerland confirming the existence of sufficient assets. Banks licensed in Switzerland are those banks, which have been approved by the Swiss Financial Market Supervisory Authority (FINMA).		
0	A fixed guarantee for the granting of training scholarships or loans (in Swiss francs)		
0	Two (2) copies of the payment confirmation covering the school fees for the first year		
Letter (of acceptance respectively certificate of matriculation of the school or University in Switzerland (original & two (2)		
Previo	us diplomas and school certificates (original & two (2) copies)		
CV (cu	CV (curriculum vitae) (in duplicate)		
Letter o	etter of motivation including intentions for the future (in duplicate)		
Written	n declaration by the student that he/she will return to Switzerland after completing his/her studies (in duplicate)

Scholarship: Switzerland offers each year two University scholarships to Turkish citizen who would like to study in Switzerland. These 9-months research scholarships are only open to university graduates. Applications must be submitted to the Turkish Ministry of Education in Ankara in October/November. The process for scholarships is conducted in cooperation with the Turkish Ministry of Education. Every August the Ministry publishes an information on its website www.meb.gov.tr.
