LIST OF DOCUMENTS

A/2 - STUDENT VISA

You want to visit Israel for the purpose of training.

MANDATORY DOCUMENTS

☐ **A new passport or a civil passport with an OVIR visa**

- *Before the expiration of the validity of the passport must be at least 7 months;*
- *Original and copy.*

☐ **Visa application form**

- *Completed in Russian or English;*
- *Printed on three separate sheets and signed.*

☐ **Two photos**

- *Color photo on a white background;*
- *Size: 5.5 x 5.5 cm;*
- *Shot in front, look directly at the camera;*
- *The mouth should be closed, teeth not visible;*
- *Without shadows on the face;*
- *Wearing glasses: eyes should not be covered by the frames of glasses;*
- *Sharp, not blurry, high resolution pixels (600 dpi);*
- *The face covers 70-80% of the photo;*
- *Recent photo, not older than 6 months (please do not use the photos you used to apply for a passport or visa 6 months ago).*

☐ **Birth or marriage certificate or certificate of divorce or death, if death of spouse**

- *If the certificate is issued in Uzbek, you must provide the original document and notarized translation into English.*

☐ **For senior citizens**

- *Original and copy of pension certificate;*
- *If the pension certificate is issued in Uzbek, you must also provide notarized copy with translation into English.*

☐ **Two copies of the receipt of payment of the consular and service fees, payment for possible Additional services**



- *Payment is made before submitting documents at the Visa Application Center.*

☐ **Solvency evidence**

- *Bank statement for the last 3 months and / or savings book;*
- *Certificate of ownership;*
- *Evidence of the student's financial means to pay for studies and accommodation in time spent in Israel.*

☐ **Except for the above requirements, when applying for a visa for children under 18 years applicants must provide:**

- *A new passport and a civil passport with an OVIR visa. Passport must be valid for at least 3 years before its expiration;*
- *Two color photographs 5.5 cm x 5.5 cm (detailed information on photo requirements available on our website on the Help page);*
- *Birth certificate, original and copy. In the event that the certificate is issued for Uzbek, you need to provide the original document and notarized translation into English and with Apostille stamp;*
- *If one of the parents has died, you must provide the original and a copy of the certificate of death of the parent. In the event that the certificate is issued in Uzbek, you need provide the original document and a notarized translation into English;*
- *If only the mother is indicated on the birth certificate, a certificate must be provided No. 16 from the registry office (certificate of a single mother), (original and copy) translated into English and certified by the seal of the Apostille. The certificate must be issued no later than 3 months at the time contacting the Visa Application Center;*
- *If one of the parents is deprived of parental rights, you must provide the original and copy of the court decision on the deprivation of parental rights. certified in English, certified seal;*
- *The document of guardianship, the original and a copy translated into English, certified stamped apostille.*

☐ **Parental consent**

- *Parents must complete and sign a leave permit form for a minor a child in the presence of an embassy employee, both must have original passports;*
- *Parents will be invited to the Israeli Embassy in Uzbekistan with prior notification from the Visa Application Center.*
- **NOTE:** *If one of the parents cannot be present at the Embassy at the time of filing permission, he / she can come to any other Embassy or Consulate of Israel with passport to apply for permission.*
